



This agreement signed pursuant to AFL Victoria rules and regulations pertaining to clearances and permits in reference to clause 2.10 – Area Permits, whereby an interchange of players between clubs of the above-mentioned Leagues may take place without clearance rather permits and is subject to any provisions contained within this agreement.

Conditions of the agreement are as follows:

1. This agreement applied for the 2021 season.
2. Players in the AFLSE Under 17's Top-Age boys' competition who are turning 17 within the competition year are eligible to participate in the Southern Football Netball League U19's and Senior Competition.
3. Players in the AFLSE Under 18's Top-Age female competition who are turning 16 within the competition year are eligible to participate in the Southern Football Netball League Senior Women's Competition.
4. A player cannot be interchanged whilst under suspension or disqualification.
5. Agreements must be signed by the player's parent or guardian and can be applied for at any stage of the 2021 season (Finals are subject to league eligibility).
6. The junior league player may only:
 - a. Play with a senior club where a junior club has an MOU and is affiliated with its senior club. (Applicable to AFLSE Top-Age U17 Boys Competition)
 - b. Where a junior club is not affiliated, then the player must nominate a senior club prior to their first match.
7. The official Interchange Agreement form must be completed prior to the player participating, signed by the player and their parent/guardian and the AFLSE Junior club President or Secretary. **This form must be forwarded to the AFLSE and SFNL office no later than 2pm Friday before the first permit game is played and be retained by the SFNL club to which the player wishes to permit.**
8. **A type 2 local interchange permit is to be submitted into Sporting Pulse by the Senior Club by 12 noon on the business day preceding the match day.** The permit must be approved through Sporting Pulse by the junior and senior clubs, AFLSE and SFNL.
9. The player can play for their SFNL club when their junior league team competition has yet to commence, has a bye or the season has completed.
10. That the player in relation to finals will only be permitted to play in one (1) finals game per weekend including Fridays.
11. The number of players that an SFNL club can request under the agreement shall be up to eight (8), provided that the junior team is fielding a side of twenty (20) in the corresponding weekend and fixture of the AFLSE and that the permitted player meets the minimum age requirements of the agreement.
12. A permitted junior must not be selected before an available registered Under 19s player.
13. Any player reported under this agreement shall have the charge heard by the Independent Tribunal of the league within which the offence occurred and both leagues shall apply the penalty. Information of the offence, report and tribunal outcome will be shared with the relevant leagues.
14. Any player of club who is found to have breached this agreement may be subject to penalties as prescribed in the AFLSE and SFNL rules and or by laws.
15. The terms and conditions of this agreement can only be altered by mutual agreement in writing between the AFL South East and SFNL.
