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## **Interchange Agreement MPNFL & AFLSE Regional Competition**

This agreement signed pursuant to AFL Victoria Country rules and regulations pertaining to clearances and permits in reference to clause 2.10 – Area Permits, whereby an interchange of players between clubs of the above mentioned leagues may take place without clearance rather permits and is subject to any provisions contained within this agreement.

Conditions of the agreement are as follows:

1. This agreement remains in place until withdrawn by AFLSE.
2. Players in the AFLSE Regional Competition - Under17's competition are eligible to participate who are turning 17 within the competition year.
3. Players are able to participate in the MPNFL Under 19s and Senior Competition.
4. A player cannot be interchanged whilst under suspension or disqualification.
5. Agreements must be signed by the player's parent or guardian and can be applied for at any stage of the season. (Finals are subject to league eligibility)
6. The junior league player may only:
  - a. Play with a senior club where a junior club has an MOU and is affiliated with its senior club.
  - b. Where a junior club is not affiliated, then the player must nominate a senior club prior to their first match.
7. The official Interchange Agreement form must be completed prior to the player participating, signed by the player and their parent/guardian and the AFLSE Junior club President or Secretary. **This form must be forwarded to the AFLSE office no later than 2pm Friday before the first permit game is played and be retained by the MPNFL club to which the player wishes to permit.**
8. **A type 2 local interchange permit is to be submitted into Sports TG by the Senior Club by 12 noon on the business day preceding the match day.** The permit dates are to begin and end on the date game will be played. The permit must be approved through Sports TG by the junior and senior clubs and AFLSE.
9. Where junior and senior competitions are scheduled on the same day, the junior player is to participate in the junior league match.



10. The player can play for his MPNFL club when his junior league team competition has yet to commence, has a bye or the season has completed.
11. That the player in relation to finals will only be permitted to play in one (1) finals game per weekend including Fridays.
12. The number of players that an MPNFL club can request under the agreement shall be up to five (5), provided that the junior team is fielding a side of twenty (20) under 17's players in the corresponding weekend and fixture of the AFLSE and that the permitted player meets the minimum age requirements of the agreement.
13. A permitted junior player can only play a maximum of 8 MPNFL games, excluding finals, during the season.
14. A permitted junior must not be selected before an available registered Under 19s player.
15. Any player reported under this agreement shall have the charge heard by the Independent Tribunal of the league within which the offence occurred and both leagues shall apply the penalty. Information of the offence, report and tribunal outcome will be shared with the relevant leagues.
16. Any player or club who is found to have breached this agreement may be subject to penalties as prescribed in the MPNFL and AFLSE Junior Competition rules and or by laws.
17. The terms and conditions of this agreement can only be altered by mutual agreement in writing between the MPNFL and AFLSE Regional Competition.
